

Activated Charcoal Face Mask Recipe

Recipe makes approximately 8- 2 oz. jars of face mask.

Here's What You Need: Ingredients

Bentonite Clay Powder
Rosemary Essential Oil
Vitamin E Oil
Vegetable Glycerin
Disposable Pipettes
2 oz. Black Double Wall Jars
Black Dome Lids 58/400
1 oz. Black Bullet Bottles
Black Smooth Disc Lids 20/410

Activated Charcoal

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Here's How It's Done : Directions

Total Recipe Weights:

96 grams Activated Charcoal 224 grams Bentonite Clay Powder 24 drops Vitamin E Oil 32 drops Rosemary Essential Oil 12 grams Vegetable Glycerin

- **Step 1:** In a medium sized bowl, begin by weighing out 96 grams of your activated charcoal using your scale.
- **Step 2:** Next, to the same bowl, add 224 grams of your bentonite clay powder. Fully mix the ingredients making sure everything is evenly dispersed.
- **Step 3:** Now, use a disposable pipette to add 24 drops of vitamin e oil.
- **Step 4:** Then, using another pipette, add 32 drops of rosemary essential oil.
- **Step 5:** Finally, use a spoon or spatula to mix the ingredients together.
- **Step 6:** The powdered portion in now finished. Go ahead and scoop the powder into your two ounce jars. Place a lid on each jar.
- **Step 7:** Next, add 12 grams of vegetable glycerin to each of your eight 1 oz. black bullet bottles. Place a disc top lid on each bottle.
- **Step 8:** To use your activated charcoal facial mask you will need a small mixing bowl. Add one tablespoon of powder, two tablespoons of water, and about 1/2 teaspoon of vegetable glycerin. Mix well. Note: We chose to package the powder and glycerin separately. By creating the mask without the water you will not need to add a preservative. This will allow you to prepare a quick product for your customers. Each two ounce jar will create approximately 4 facial masks.
- **Step 9:** Now, apply a thin layer to your face. Allow the mask to harden. Then, rinse with warm water.
