

### **Beard Conditioner Recipe**

Recipe makes approximately 2-8 ounce bottles.

## Here's What You Need: Ingredients

Amber Waters Fragrance Oil
BTMS 25 Emulsifier
Jojoba Oil
Vegetable Glycerin
Vitamin E Oil
Optiphen Preservative
8 oz Boston Round Bottles
Black Lotion Pump 24/410
Thermometer

#### Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Mixing Bowls
Mixing Spoons
Stick Blender
Pots (3)
Funnel
Water
Scale



# Here's How It's Done : Directions

#### **Total Recipe Weights:**

425 grams Distilled Water
20 grams Jojoba Oil
25 grams Vegetable Glycerin
25 grams BTMS 25 Emulsifier
26 grams Amber Waters Fragrance Oil
5 grams Vitamin E Oil
5 grams Optiphen Preservative

Clean and sanitize your work area as well as your packaging. We suggest that you wear gloves, protective clothing, and a hair net while preparing this recipe.

**Step 1:** In one of your pots, heat your water to at least 180F and hold for 20 minutes to destroy any bacteria. Remove from heat and set aside. Keep in mind, you will have some evaporation. So, you will want to heat extra water so that you will have 425 grams when you are finished.

**Step 2:** Using a double boiler, melt the jojoba oil, vegetable glycerin, and BTMS.

**Step 3:** When the contents of each pot are around 140F, combine them. Use a stick blender to emulsify them.

**Step 4:** Once the temperature reaches about 120F, add the Optiphen, Amber Waters Fragrance Oil, and the Vitamin E Oil. Once again, stick blend.

**Step 5:** Allow the conditioner to cool to room temperature. It will continue to thicken as it cools. Then, using your funnel, add the conditioner to the bottles and place a lotion pump on each one.

Your beard conditioner can be used right away. Enjoy!

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
