Blarney Stone Soap Recipe

Recipe makes 6 bars of soap.

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Scale
Mixing Bowls (6)
Mixing Spoon
Knife
12 oz. Plastic Cups (6)
Rubbing Alcohol



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Total Weights for Bowl 1:

305 grams Diamond Clear Melt and Pour Soap
15 grams White Tea & Ginger Fragrance Oil

Total Recipe Weights for Bowl 2:

585 grams Mango Butter Melt and Pour Soap
29 grams White Tea & Ginger Fragrance Oil

Total Weights for Bowl 3:

473 grams Mango Butter Melt and Pour Soap
23 grams White Tea & Ginger Fragrance Oil
20 drops Kelly Green FUN Soap Colorant

Total Weights for Bowl 4:

450 grams Diamond Clear Melt and Pour Soap
22 grams White Tea & Ginger Fragrance Oil
8 drops Kelly Green FUN Soap Colorant

Total Weights for Bowl 5:

457 grams Mango Butter Melt and Pour Soap
22 grams White Tea and Ginger Fragrance Oil
20 drops Neon Green FUN Soap Colorant

Total Recipe Weights for Bowl 6:

213 grams Diamond Clear Melt and Pour Soap
10 grams White Tea and Ginger Fragrance Oil
5 drops Black Oxide FUN Soap Colorant

Step 1: Begin by setting out six separate mixing bowls and six 12 oz. cups.

Step 2: Now, begin melting your soap. Once melted, add the White Tea and Ginger Fragrance Oil and mix to incorporate. Then, add the FUN Soap Colorants as specified above. Again, mix to incorporate.

Step 3: Next, begin layering the soap. After pouring each layer, you need to spray the soap with rubbing alcohol. This will release any air bubbles and allow the layers to adhere to each other. You can layer the melted soap in any order or thickness you would like. We also layered in about 1 gram of 24K Gold Mica to each cup. In addition, we periodically propped the cups up on one side using post-it note pads. You can use what ever you have available to slightly tilt the cup. If you choose to do this, it will add angles to the layers and create a beautiful effect to the finished soap.

Step 4: Once you have filled all six cups, allow the soap to harden and remove them from the plastic cups.

Step 5: Finally, cut your soap. Using a knife, cut off pieces of the soap at an angle. The goal is to create a rock. We found that the more angles we cut, the more it took on the shape of a rock.

Your Blarney Stone Soap is now ready to use! Enjoy!
