



Holiday Pomegranate Candle Recipe

Recipe makes one candle.

Here's What You Need:
Ingredients

[Joy Wax](#)

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

16 oz. Glass Apothecary Jar
Scale
Mixing Spoons
Knife
Hot Glue Gun and Stick
Pot (For Double Boiler)
Pan
Wax Paper



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Step 1: Create your pomegranates. Weigh out and melt 20 grams of the beeswax and add just a small amount of the scarlet color block. Also, add 2 grams of the Holiday Pomegranate Fragrance Oil. Stir. Pour the wax onto a pan lined with wax paper. Once setup, cut three small circles out of the wax.

Step 2: Create your leaves. Now, weigh out 20 grams of the beeswax. Weigh out and melt 20 grams of the beeswax and add just a small amount of the bayberry color block. Also, add 2 grams of the Holiday Pomegranate Fragrance Oil. Stir. Pour the wax onto a pan lined with wax paper. Once setup, cut three holly leaves out of the wax.

Step 3: Weigh out 120 grams of Pillar of Bliss Candle Wax. Use a double boiler to melt the candle wax.

Step 4: Once your wax is melted, add about 4 grams of a scarlet color block. Stir to incorporate the colorant.

Step 5: Now, to the wax add 12 grams of Nature's Garden's Holiday Pomegranate Fragrance Oil. Once again, stir the wax to blend the ingredients.

Step 6: Next, pour some of the candle wax into each cavity of the silicone four loaf mold. We will be cutting this wax into chunks in a later step. Another option is to pour it into a wax paper lined baking pan. Allow the wax to setup, but still be warm to the touch.

Step 7: Once the wax has setup, remove it from the mold. Then, use a knife to cut the wax into square pieces.

Step 8: Weigh out and melt 300 grams of the Joy Wax using a double boiler.

Step 9: Once melted, add about 3 grams of a white color block. Then, stir until the colorant is fully incorporated.

Step 10: Also, to the Joy Wax, add 30 grams of the Holiday Pomegranate Fragrance Oil. Once again, stir to incorporate the fragrance oil.

Step 11: Next, add your wicks to the jar, adhering them with hot glue. You want to make sure that your wick tabs are centered and evenly placed in the jar.



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Step 12: Pour the melted wax into the candle jar. Then, drop your scarlet colored cubes gently into the jar.

Step 13: Now, allow your candle to setup. Then, melt 100 grams of the Joy Wax. Add a small amount of the white color block. You will need about 1 gram.

Step 14: Add 10 grams of the Holiday Pomegranate Fragrance Oil to the wax and stir to blend the scent.

Step 15: Allow the wax to cool slightly. Then, begin whipping it until you have a whipped consistency. Finally, place the wax on top of the candle. Then, place the holly leaves and berries on top of the whipped wax to resemble a holly berry.

Once cured, your Holiday Pomegranate Candle will be ready to burn. Enjoy!

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
