# Mahogany Teakwood Bath Bomb Recipe

*Recipe makes approximately 6 bath bombs.*

Here's What You Need:  
Ingredients

[NG Mahogany Teakwood Type Fragrance Oil](#)

## **Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:**

Witch Hazel (in spray bottle)  
Mixing Bowls  
Mixing Spoon  
Scale



## Here's How It's Done : Directions

### **Total Recipe Amounts:**

670 grams Citric Acid  
235 grams Baking Soda  
14 grams Kaolin Clay Powder  
14 grams Castor Oil  
14 grams NG Mahogany Teakwood Type Fragrance Oil

### **Colorants for Light Brown Portion:**

10 drops Brown Oxide FUN Soap Colorant  
3 drops Black Oxide FUN Soap Colorant

### **Colorants for Red Brown Portion:**

3 drops Brown Oxide FUN Soap Colorant  
3 drops Red Oxide FUN Soap Colorant  
10 drops Tomato Red FUN Soap Colorant  
3 drops Black Oxide FUN Soap Colorant

### **Colorants for Dark Brown Portion:**

20 drops Brown Oxide FUN Soap Colorant  
6 drops Black Oxide FUN Soap Colorant

### **Colorants for Tan Portion:**

10 drops Yellow Oxide FUN Soap Colorant

**This recipe is best prepared in non-humid climates.**

Before you start, clean and sanitize your work area as well as all of your packaging materials. We also suggest wearing gloves, protective clothing, and a hair net while creating this bath fizzy recipe. In addition, prepare your spray bottle, filling it with witch hazel.

**Step 1:** Begin by weighing out your baking soda, citric acid, and Kaolin clay powder. Using your hands, break up any clumps in the mixture.

**Step 2:** Now, add the NG Mahogany Teakwood Type Fragrance Oil and castor oil. Use your hands to mix the ingredients together. You will want to be certain that the oils are fully and evenly mixed into the dry ingredients.

**Step 3:** Then, you will need to separate your mixture. Divide the ingredients evenly into four bowls.

**Step 4:** Add the colorants. Using the guide above, add one of the colorants to each bowl. Using clean gloved hands, mix the contents of each bowl.

**Step 5:** Lightly spritz the first bowl of mixture with witch hazel. Mix the mixture. Continue spritzing with witch hazel until the mixture feels like crumbly dough in your hands. Do not overspray. Repeat this process with the remaining bowls.



## Here's How It's Done : Directions

**Step 6:** Begin filling your molds. We will be layering the bath bombs for this recipe. Place a layer of the tan colored mixture into each half of six molds. Then, add layers of red-brown, light brown, and dark brown to each half of the molds. Pack the molds tightly as you are filling them.

**Step 7:** Now, once all of your molds are full, spritz two halves of the bath bomb molds with witch hazel. Then, attach the halves together.

**Step 8:** Allow the bath bombs to set up before removing them from the molds.
