

## Pancakes MP Soap Recipe

Recipe makes approximately 5 bars of soap.

## Here's What You Need: Ingredients

Sunday Brunch Fragrance Oil
Soya Milk Melt and Pour Soap Base
Diamond Clear Melt and Pour Soap Base
Da Bomb Soap Dye Red
Da Bomb Soap Dye Yellow
Brown Oxide FUN Soap Colorant
Yellow Oxide FUN Soap Colorant
8 oz Clear Bullet Bottle
24/410 White Fine Mist Sprayer
Silicone Mold Brownie Bites Mold

## Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Scale

Microwave

Knife

**Cutting Board** 

Mixing Bowl

Mixing Spoon

Alcohol (in bullet bottle)

Sugar Cookies Mold (www.flexiblemolds.com)

Pan (lined with wax paper)



## Here's How It's Done : Directions

**Step 1:** First, we will prepare the pancakes. Weigh out and melt 375 grams of the Soya Milk Melt and Pour Soap Base. Once melted add 15 drops of the yellow oxide and 3 drops of the brown oxide FUN Soap Colorants. In addition, add 16 grams of the Sunday Brunch Fragrance Oil and 16 grams of the Vanilla White Color Stabilizer. Stir. Pour the melted soap into the cookie mold. Spray with alcohol and allow them to set up before removing them from the molds.

**Step 2:** Prepare the butter. You will need to melt 25 grams of the Soya Milk MP Soap Base. Once melted, use a toothpick to add a very small amount of the neon yellow FUN Soap Colorant. Stir. Pour about 5 grams of the melted soap into five of the cavities of the brownie bites mold. Allow these to set up before removing them from the mold.

**Step 3:** Next, we will prepare the syrup. Weigh out and melt 50 grams of the Diamond Clear Melt and Pour Base. Once melted, add 2 drops of the yellow Da Bomb Soap Dye, 1 drop of the red Da Bomb Soap Dye, and use a toothpick to add a very small amount of the brown FUN Soap Colorant. Stir.

**Step 4:** At this time, we will begin putting everything together. Place the pancakes in front of you with the smooth side up. Spray each one with the alcohol. Then, we will begin stacking them. Each stack will need three pancakes. In addition, you will need to put a few grams of syrup between them. Once you have created a stack of three, pour some syrup over them and place the butter on top while the syrup is still fluid.

**Step 5:** Once the soap has set up, it is ready to use!
