



Shimmering Snowdrops Lotion Recipe

Recipe makes approximately 2- 8 ounce jars of thick lotion.

Other Ingredients & Equipment You'll Need:

Mixing Bowls
Mixing Spoon
Distilled Water
Stick Blender
Scale



Here's How It's Done : Directions

Total Recipe Amounts:

- 4 ounces Soy Body Butter Multi-Base Lotion
- 7.5 ounces Distilled Water
- 9 ml Frost and Snowdrops Fragrance Oil
- 2 tsp Diamond Dust Mica Pigment
- 4 drops Da Bomb Soap Dye

Clean and sanitize your workstation and all of your packaging materials and utensils. It is suggested that you wear gloves, an apron, gloves, a face mask, and a hair net while preparing this recipe.

Step 1: First, you will need to prepare your water. Weigh out your distilled water. Make sure to include extra water so that you have at least 7.5 ounces for the recipe. Now, heat the water to at least 185 degrees Fahrenheit. Once the water hits this temperature, hold it there for a minimum of 5 minutes. Remove the water from the heat source and weigh out the 7.5 ounces.

Step 2: Next, you will need to allow your water to cool. Your water temperature should be around 100 degrees Fahrenheit when working with the multi-bases. If the water is too hot, it can break down the base.

Step 3: Once the water is at the proper temperature, add the soy multi-base. Use your stick blender to mix the two ingredients together. As the mixture cools it will continue to thicken.

Step 4: Finally, to your lotion, add the Frost and Snowdrops Fragrance Oil, Da Bomb Soap Dye, and Diamond Dust Mica. Once again, mix the lotion to incorporate all of the ingredients.

Step 5: Once your lotion has cooled, place it in the 8 ounce clear jars. Then, place a lid on top.

Your shimmering snowdrops lotion is now ready to use!
